

**OLD CATTON PARISH COUNCIL, MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE
PLANNING AND PROPERTY COMMITTEE HELD AT 7.30 P.M.,
ON THURSDAY 12TH SEPTEMBER, 2002, AT THE PAVILION, CHURCH STREET**

1. ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN AND VICE CHAIRMAN

Mrs G Masdin welcomed everybody to the first meeting of the Committee and invited nominations for Chairman.

Miss P Wilkin PROPOSED and Mr S Dunn SECONDED that Mr B Sabberton-Coe be elected as Chairman. There were no other nominations and this was AGREED unanimously.

Mr S Dunn PROPOSED and Mr F Colbridge SECONDED that Mr M Vincent be elected as Vice Chairman. There were no other nominations and this was AGREED unanimously.

Mr B Sabberton-Coe took the Chair.

2. ELECTION OF RECREATION GROUNDS COMMITTEE

It was AGREED that Miss P Wilkin, Mr F Colbridge, Mr C Green and Mr D Little would serve on the Committee and that Mr B Sabberton-Coe would be an ex officio member as Chairman of the Planning and Property Committee.

3. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest.

4. CHURCH STREET RECREATION GROUND

The attached quotations for fencing were considered. It was AGREED to accept Walpole Fencing's quotation for 17 metres of fencing in the sum of £417.53. This area was currently unfenced. It was AGREED to leave the other 21 metres until the next year as the budget provision might not be adequate.

5. LAVARE PARK

The attached quotations for replacing a section of the fence of the play area were considered. The fence had been damaged by use as a football goal. Means of saving the fence by placing seats in front of it had been considered but dismissed as ineffective and costly. It was AGREED to accept Walpole Fencing's quotation for Weldmesh fencing in the sum of £459.00.
