49. MATTERS ARISING

Minute 42. Key to barrier at Lavare Park. Mr Tolliday reported that there had been another accident when the key had been useful. The football club did not have a procedure for recording accidents.

50. CLUB REPORTS

50.1. Tennis Club. Miss Booty reported that the new lines had been painted.

50.2. Junior Football Club. Mr Tolliday reported that the club had had its Presentation Evening in May and would be holding its Five a Side Tournament on 8th and 9th June and the AGM in July.

51. CHURCH STREET RECREATION GROUND

The fence between the children's play area and 3 Greyfriars Close had been rebuilt, the cost being shared between the Council and the neighbour. It was noted that the fence was not defined as the Council's responsibility in its deeds; the builder of Greyfriars Close had built the old wall and the Council had placed the fence on top of the wall.

52. LAVARE PARK

The long side of the play area fence, facing the field, had been used as a goal and was leaning over. Members thought that a seat situated in front of the fence might deter using the area for football.
