

6. PLANNING APPLICATION 20040879, LPA MAST AT WHITE WOMAN LANE

It was unanimously AGREED to object strongly to this application for the same reasons as an earlier application. It was noted, with regret, that the previous application had been allowed by the DoE on appeal, despite the opposition from the Council, Broadland District Council and residents.

It was AGREED to write to Norfolk County Council commenting on the use of its land which seemed to be at variance with the objections from its local schools.

The reasons for opposing the application were close proximity to dense housing and the strong objection of those residents, concern about the closeness to schools and the loss of visual amenity, especially if there were to be two masts.

There being no further business the Chairman thanked everybody for attending and closed the meeting at 8.15 p.m..
