



**50. REVIEW OF WORK OUTSTANDING**

The attached list was reviewed.

**51. STREET LIGHTING AT ST FAITHS ROAD**

Norfolk County Council's Street Lighting Engineer had advised on ways to improve the lighting at St Faiths Road. His recommended option was to replace all the columns with 6 meter columns with Urbis 70 watt high pressure sodium lamps and to add extra columns.

It was AGREED to obtain quotations to do this at St Faiths Road, as far as Lodge Lane, and to replace all the other concrete columns (at The Warren, Lovett Close and Overstone Court). It was noted that the Finance and Policy Committee had already agreed to this work being financed by way of a loan.

**52. IMPROVEMENTS TO THE ENTRANCE OF THE CEMETERY**

Mr C Emberson, the architect, had quoted to design and administer the improvements at hourly rates of £50 for design and £25.00 for administration and other work, he thought the maximum charge would be £600.00.

The Finance and Policy Committee had agreed to the Committee's request that the work might be completed in the current financial year using the unbudgeted for additional income from burials as well as the sum already allowed for repairs and maintenance.

It was AGREED to instruct Mr Emberson to carry out the design for the Council's approval as soon as possible.
