**45. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

Mr K Leggett, Mr B Sabberton-Coe and Mr D Thompson declared their personal interests in the Catton Park Trust.

**46. MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF 26.10.2006**

The minutes, which had been circulated, were confirmed as a true record, and signed by the Chairman.

It was AGREED to adjourn the meeting for public discussion.  
The meeting resumed.

**47. FINANCE AND POLICY COMMITTEE**

47.1. Mrs G Masdin PROPOSED the confirmation and adoption of the minutes of the meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> November 2006. AGREED.

Budget for 2007/8. The Committee had recommended a precept of £148,000.00 and had explained the reasons for this. The matter was discussed and it was PROPOSED by Mrs G Masdin and SECONDED by Mrs A Chandler that the budget be agreed and a precept of £148,000 be levied on Broadland District Council for the financial year 2007/8. AGREED UNANIMOUSLY.

Payments and receipts. The list, which had been approved by the Committee was AGREED.

#### **48. PLANNING AND PROPERTY COMMITTEE**

48.1. Mr B Sabberton-Coe PROPOSED the confirmation and adoption of the minutes of the meeting of 13.11.2006. AGREED.

48.2. Matters arising from the minutes. Mr C Green had visited Sloughbottom Park and looked at the MUGA there; he considered the fencing to be excellent and durable.

48.3. Quotations to replace showers. It was PROPOSED by Miss P Wilkin that Kevin Cooke's quotation in the sum of £1,730.00 be accepted and the work put in hand. AGREED.

48.4. Quotation for work in the wooded area of the Recreation Ground. It was PROPOSED by Mr K Leggett that James Oxbury's quotation in the sum of £6,768.75 be accepted and the work put in hand early in 2007. AGREED. It was also AGREED that the work be funded partly from the Recreation Ground budget with the remainder from other savings and Section 106 monies.

#### **49. VILLAGE HALL**

Mrs G Masdin reported that the recent lunch had been very successful, enjoyable, and had made a profit of about £350.00.

#### **50. CATTON PARK**

Mr K Leggett gave an update on the work in the Park. In answer to a question he explained that parts of the new paths would have some further work done to them as they had been affected by bad weather. The type of path being made was the best the budget would allow.

The Chairman thanked everybody for attending and closed the meeting at 8.00 p.m.
