The Chairman welcomed everybody to the meeting.

10. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Mr K Leggett, Mr B Sabberton-Coe and Mr D Thompson declared their personal interests in the Catton Park Trust.

Members were all asked to update the record of their interests or confirm they had not changed.

11. MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF 25.5.2006

The minutes, which had been circulated, were confirmed as a true record, and signed by the Chairman.

It was AGREED to adjourn the meeting for public discussion.

12. THE LAUNCH OF 'BROADLAND LIFE'

Following the discussion that had taken place in both Committees the members had met, informally, with the Broadland Life Coordinator, Mrs S Flack, prior to the meeting to discuss the proposed launch of Broadland District Council's initiative at the Recreation Ground.

It was unanimously AGREED that the event should be hosted at the Recreation Ground. The main features of the event would be organised by Broadland District Council with Village Organisations having the opportunity to use stalls to publicise their organisations and raise funds. Charges for stalls and shares of profits would be earmarked for the planned Multi Use Games Area at the Recreation Ground.

It was AGREED to form a small committee to deal with this comprising of the Chairman, Mr B Sabberton-Coe, Miss P Wilkin, Mr K Leggett and the Clerk.
