Minute 47.1. It was noted that the adult fitness equipment and the new 'big' swings had been installed.

Minute 47.2. It was noted that the new gates had been erected at the Recreation Ground. The tarmac surface under the old gates had yet to be resurfaced and then the fixings for the gates would be completed.

Minute 51.1. It was noted that the new railings had been installed at the Churchyard extension.

34. VILLAGE HALL

Mrs G Masdin reported that the Management Committee had decided to re-roof the garages. The recent quiz had raised over £300. The Hall was being well booked.

35. CATTON PARK

It was noted that a customer survey was to be carried out during the half term holidays; councillors, members of the Old Catton Society and the Friends of Catton Park would talk to people using the Park to identify how its use had progressed. The gates at South Lodge were being renovated; the work had proved to be more complicated than anticipated and the costs had increased.
